Beekeeping Club

(Grades K - 13)

What's the buzz about bees? Using beeswax, make projects such as candles and lip balm. Cook some tasty treats with honey. Learn about beekeeping, bee behavior, and the importance of pollinators.

Chaps & Spurs

(Grades 3 - 13)

Love horses? If the answer is yay, not neigh, this club is for you! Through horse-themed crafts and hands-on activities, learn about breeds, colors, feeding, care, equipment, riding styles, and working safely with large animals. Members don't need to own a horse.

(Grades K - 13)

(Grades K - 13)

Discovery Prep

(Grades K - 3)

(Grades K - 13)

Rabbits, Cavies, and Rodents! Learn about proper care and handling of small animals, safety, and responsible pet ownership.

Members do not need to own a small animal.

Game On!

(Grades 3 - 13)

Do you like to play Roblox, Minecraft, Smash Bros, and other Nintendo games? Or do you like Chess, Battleship, Catan, and other board games? Learn new games, teamwork, explore creativities & skills, socialize, and have friendly game time.

Gingersnaps

(Grades K - 13)

Through hands-on activities, members gain experience preparing food. In addition, members can express their uniqueness through creative craft projects.

Go-Kart Juniors

(Grades 2 - 3)

Ready, set, go! Experience the thrill of gokart driving in a safe and supervised environment. Learn essential safety practices, from proper safety gear use to kart maintenance, while building and customizing your go-kart. Master driving techniques; engage in exciting, timed laps; and discover the ins and outs of the kart. Enjoy speed and fun with a strong focus on safety and teamwork.

Hip-Hop Hoppers

(Grades K - 3)

Do you like to jam to your favorite songs on the radio? Learn how to stomp to the beat, clap to the rhythm, and flow with the music all while having fun. Members will also have the opportunity to perform in front of a live audience.

Lego Masters

(Grades K - 3)

Build Lego masterpieces while enjoying the company of others. Each meeting will have a different theme. *Meets in Manville, NJ.*

Little Woofers

(Grades 1 - 3)

Welcome, dog lovers! Learn about dog handling and care (obedience, jr. showmanship and grooming) and participate in a dog show purely for the joy of doing so. Members must own (or be able to borrow) a dog.

Mad Scientists Prep Club

(Grades K - 3)

Explore! Experiment! Explain!
Learn about the world around us through
interactive science activities. Each member,
with the help of their parent/guardian, will
plan and lead a meeting.

New Centre Dairy Prep

(Grades K - 3)

Got Milk? Learn about the dairy and agricultural industries and work with calves at the farm. Members lease an animal through our Loan-a-Calf program to learn how to work with the animal and show it in the ring.

Outdoor Club

(Grades 3 - 7)

Get ready to explore our natural world together. Build connection and community through outdoor activities and experiences. Members will explore local parks and landscapes together by hiking, apple picking, or beach trips.

People Pick-Me-Ups

(Grades 1 - 13)

Learn the importance of community service in this pet therapy club. Bring your pets (dogs, cats, guinea pigs, rabbits) to help people in nursing homes and VA hospitals. Collect/deliver donations, and assist at an animal rescue ranch.

(Grades K - 3)

Participate in arts and crafts, storytelling, and creative dramatics. In the summer, members have an opportunity to perform with our sister club, The Clover Ensemble.

Proud 2B PREP

(Grades K - 3)

Explore some of the many different project areas available through 4-H, cook, and enjoy fun craft projects.

Puppet Design Prep Club

(Grades 1 - 3)

Get ready for some puppet show fun! Learn how hand puppets and marionettes move. Explore how stuffed animals and dolls can come to life. Enjoy pretend play while sparking creativity, expanding attention span, and enhancing fine motor skills.

Radio Control Car Club

(Grades K - 13)

Get ready to race! In this club, a love of vehicles, speed, and racing all combine! Enjoy the fun of racing and learn about the mechanics, driving, and types of remote control cars. We emphasize friendship, teamwork, and safety while fostering an environment of fun competition. Make new friends. Learn about r/c cars. Join the fun!

That's Sew Crafty

(Grades K - 13)
